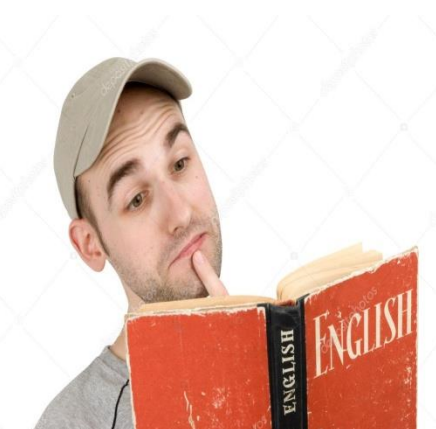

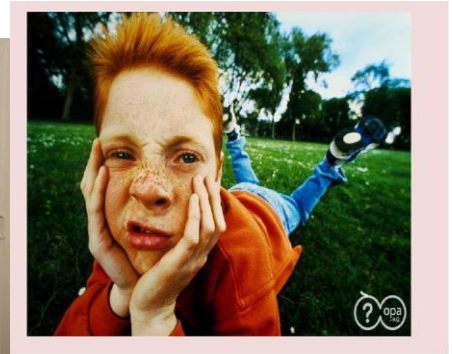

The first parachute jump

On October, 22nd, 1797 André-Jacques Garnerin did the first successful parachute jump. It was a new, unique breathtaking experience. The brave man became a legend immediately after the jump. No one had ever attempted to drop from a dizzying height before him.

André-Jacques Garnerin was born in Paris on the 31st of January, 1769. He was captured during the Napoleonic Wars. For two years he was a prisoner of war in Buda in Hungary. This fact didn't make him give in. In prison he began thinking of a plan how to get out. The air way was the most suitable to him. At that time he started designing a parachute that could finally give him freedom. His attempts were not successful and he had to serve three years in captivity.

André-Jacques had developed his interest in flying several years before. In 1790 he built a hot air balloon and successfully rose in the air.

In 1797 the Frenchman finally dared to do the first parachute jump in history. He got into the basket of a hot air balloon and then jumped out of it over Monceau Park in his home city, Paris.

The jump was extremely frightening. His parachute did not have a special hole in the canopy (купол), so air streams made it swing. But thanks to his bravery the parachutist made his landing, though it was a hard one.

A big crowd of people was waiting for André-Jacques Garnerin around his landing spot. He became a hero. His wife Jeanne-Geneviève Labrosse shared his passion for flying. She became the first woman parachutist in the world.

On 5 July, 1802 André-Jacques made his second balloon ascent with Edward Hawke Locker from Lord's Cricket Ground in London. They travelled 17 miles from there to Chingford in just 15 minutes. They had a letter of introduction signed by the Prince Regent to give to anyone in case of a crash. However, when the war between France and Great Britain restarted, they returned to the continent. On 3rd–4th October 1803, André-Jacques covered a distance of 245 miles between Paris and Clausen, Germany, with his balloon.

It's ironic but André-Jacques died in a balloon accident. On the 18th of August, 1823 he was killed by a trunk of a tree when he was loading his balloon. He died at the age of 54.

Don't make this mistake if your dog has run away

Should your dog run away when you take it out for a walk, never make this common mistake. Do not run after you four-legged friend in any possible direction. Experts give their advice and tell us how to behave in such a situation.

There are a number of reasons why dogs get lost. Some of them follow their hunter's instinct or just pick up another dog's smell and start tracking it. In some cases your dog may get frightened by a loud noise or a clap and make off. If your dog has disappeared, the best decision is to wait for it on exactly the same spot. Then you have a very good chance of getting your pet back.

If your dog has not returned within three hours, the dog owner should take a few possible steps. In some countries it is possible to report your missing dog to the police or special organisations which deal with lost animals. If your pet has a chip implanted and it is officially registered, the chance of finding your dog is pretty high. Another opportunity is to spread the information about your dog in printed and electronic forms. It should have the most important facts about your dog: its breed (a husky, a retriever, a shepherd dog etc.), age, the place where it got lost etc. A lot of dog owners also put information on their pets' collars (a leather or metal belt around a dog's neck). Such tags usually contain the telephone number or the address of the dog's master. It is very important to make the information visible and readable.

Besides, if you surf the Internet you will find a number of special websites in your country to help you find your pet.

Many websites can add your pet, which has either a microchip or a tattoo with information, to their databases. It increases the chance of finding your lost pet.

And one more thing — do not forget to offer a reward to the people who may find your lost four-legged friend. As they say, in most cases pets are returned to their owners. Today there are a lot of ways to spread your message about the missing animal. Remember — when this happens — don't panic; just follow the advice of the specialists.

A raccoon as a pet — is it a good idea?

The shortest answer to the question is certainly "no". In fact, raccoons (еноты) are quite different from what we generally imagine when we think about them. They are typical wild animals.

Of course, they look funny, unusual and attractive in their black masks. They have clever button eyes, small paws that look like human hands and are often presented as sweet, intelligent and brave animals. That is an image created in films and stories. But keeping a raccoon as a pet is quite irresponsible; no matter what you may read about it on the Internet or hear directly from its owners.

These animals are extremely curious and you will never be able to tame (приручить) them as they are not domestic. They constantly use their sharp teeth, especially when frightened or when they want to protect their babies. It is not clear at first sight but raccoons can seriously injure other pets, such as dogs and cats, and even their owners.

At home raccoons always gnaw (грызут) furniture and plants. It is not at all surprising, since their natural habitat is a forest and not a closed space.

Raccoons are efficient climbers; that's why it is hardly possible to keep anything safe from them. Besides, there are a lot of videos where we see that wild raccoons like to steal things from people's houses.

What a raccoon-keeper should remember is the following: at the age of fifteen they have the same life experience as a domestic adult cat, they need a lot of motion and physical activity and they are not able to live alone. If you can fulfil such conditions, then you may think about getting a raccoon.

Most people adopt their raccoons in spring when babies are found in the wild. It does not always mean that their parents leave them; sometimes they just go away in search of food. Raccoons eat practically everything: berries, fruit, nuts and acorns as well as different insects, worms, eggs, small mammals and even birds. They often look for food in litter bins with food waste or in bowls of dogs and other domestic animals.
